What is SmartyGrants?

SmartyGrants is a cloud-based grants administration software and data science solution that is powerful and flexible enough to meet the needs of every type of grantmaker, every size of grantmaker, and grantmakers operating in any part of the world.

SmartyGrants is licensed under a transparent annual subscription fee based on the grantmaker's annual disbursement¹.

It's used by hundreds of grantmakers to manage the allocation of more than \$7 billion in grants each year to tens of thousands of applicants in 32 countries.

SmartyGrants is an initiative of the award-winning 'business for purpose' enterprise Our Community, an Australian company that provides advice, connections, training and technology tools for people and organisations working to create positive change and build stronger communities. We were one of the first companies in Australia to legally mandate our social mission by enshrining our values in our constitution.

SmartyGrants helps to reform and streamline the flow of grants from government, business and philanthropy into the wider community.

But it's more than a grants administration system; it's also a tool for understanding and improving grantmaking through data science, peer learning, grantmaking education and in-built tools. 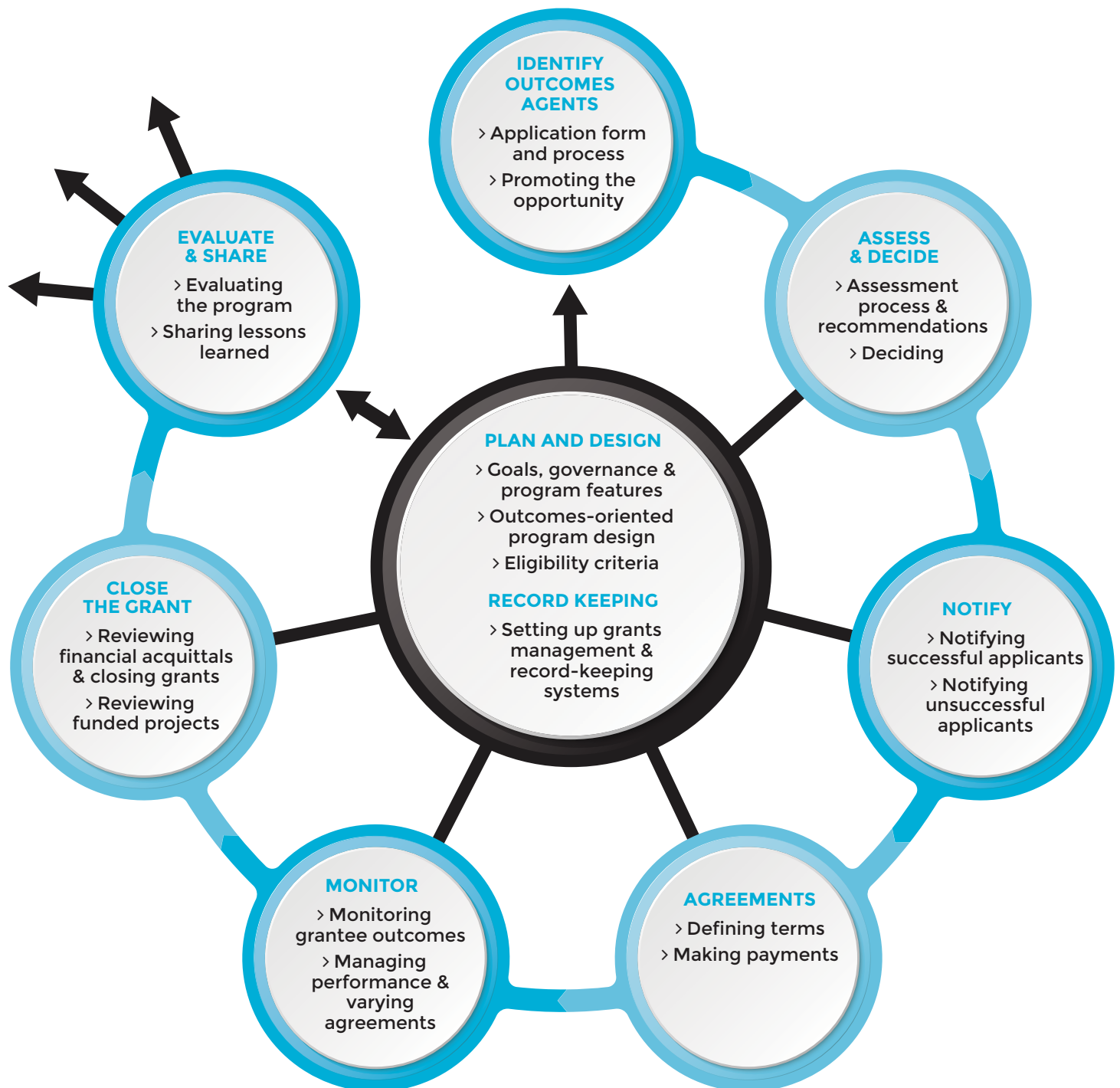

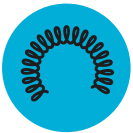

SmartyGrants is a division of the multi-award-winning social purpose enterprise Our Community, which for over two decades has been at the forefront of grants innovation in Australia. Our grantmaking reform agenda is based on three main themes:

1

Thought leadership

Our Community built Australia's first grants discovery portal (EasyGrants), published Australia's first cross-sector grantmaking journal (Grants Management Intelligence), and built Australia's first cloud-based grants administration solution (SmartyGrants).

Our internationally acclaimed Grantmaking Manifesto sets out what drives us in pushing for reform and professionalisation in grantmaking, while our Codes of Practice for Grantmakers and Grantmaking Organisations provide guidelines for better practices in grantmaking.

Education, professionalisation and peer exchange

Through our conferences, training sessions and networking events, we bring grantmakers together to share common problems and nut out practical solutions.

Through our publications, our website, our online grantmaking forum and our grantmaking services, we identify and disseminate sound, practical and innovative practices.

Through our regular surveys and other research programs, we identify benchmarks against which grantmakers of all kinds can measure their performance.

Standardisation

Our standardisation agenda provides practical tools to help grantmakers remove red tape, simplify forms, streamline reporting and effortlessly uncover deep insights into funding patterns. Our data science initiatives are helping us speed up those processes.

Through our Managed Services division we provide assistance to grantmakers who wish to overhaul their data governance to ensure a direct route from guidelines to forms to reports.

Coming soon: CLASSIEfier

Australia's first automatic grants classification tool, CLASSIEfier gives funders the power to instantly reveal funding patterns and gaps. Following five years of development and testing by data scientists and developers, this central plank of Our Community's standardisation agenda will soon be integrated into SmartyGrants.

The algorithmic system works by reading grant applications to automatically assign labels defined by CLASSIE, our social sector "dictionary". CLASSIEfier takes its name from that dictionary. Developed by SmartyGrants' parent company, Our Community, the CLASSIE taxonomy classifies the social sector by organisation, subject and population.

Already widely used, CLASSIE has been adopted by the Australian Charities and Not-for-profits Commission's online charity

search portal, among others. CLASSIE has been available to SmartyGrants users for several years, but until recently users were required to assign CLASSIE labels manually when filling in, assessing or managing forms.

CLASSIEfier removes the need for human classification with its keyword-matching algorithm. Results are available instantly via labels applied to each classified application form, while collective results (e.g. total funding by subject; funding split by beneficiary type) are shown on the grantmaker's dashboard. For example, an arts grantmaker who wants to know what proportion of their budget went to ballet versus contemporary dance versus hip-hop has effortless access to this information.

CLASSIEfier will be free for SmartyGrants users.

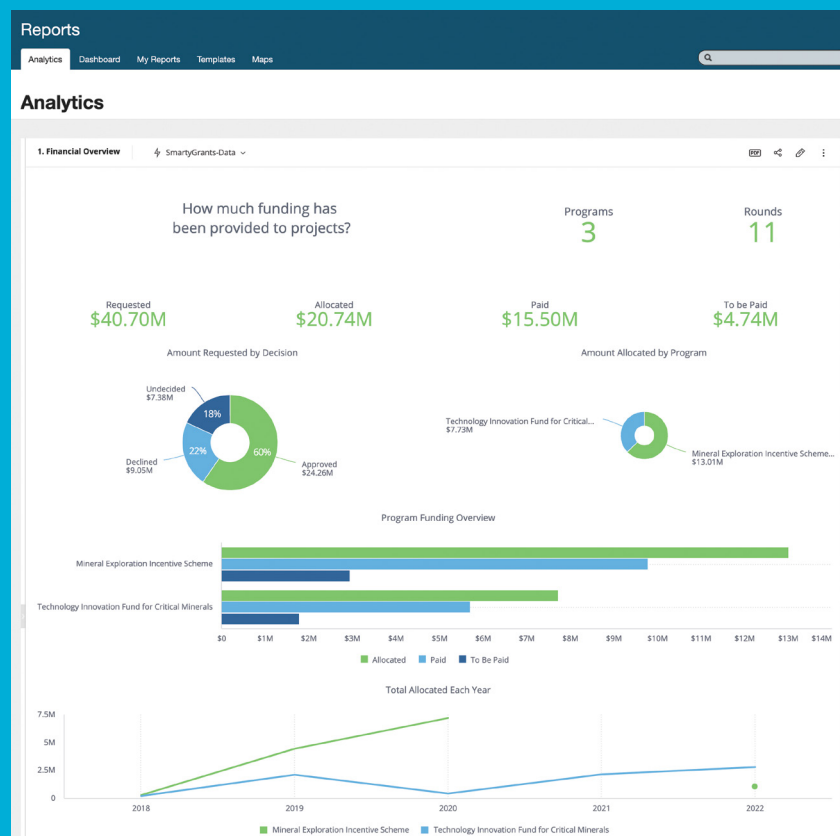

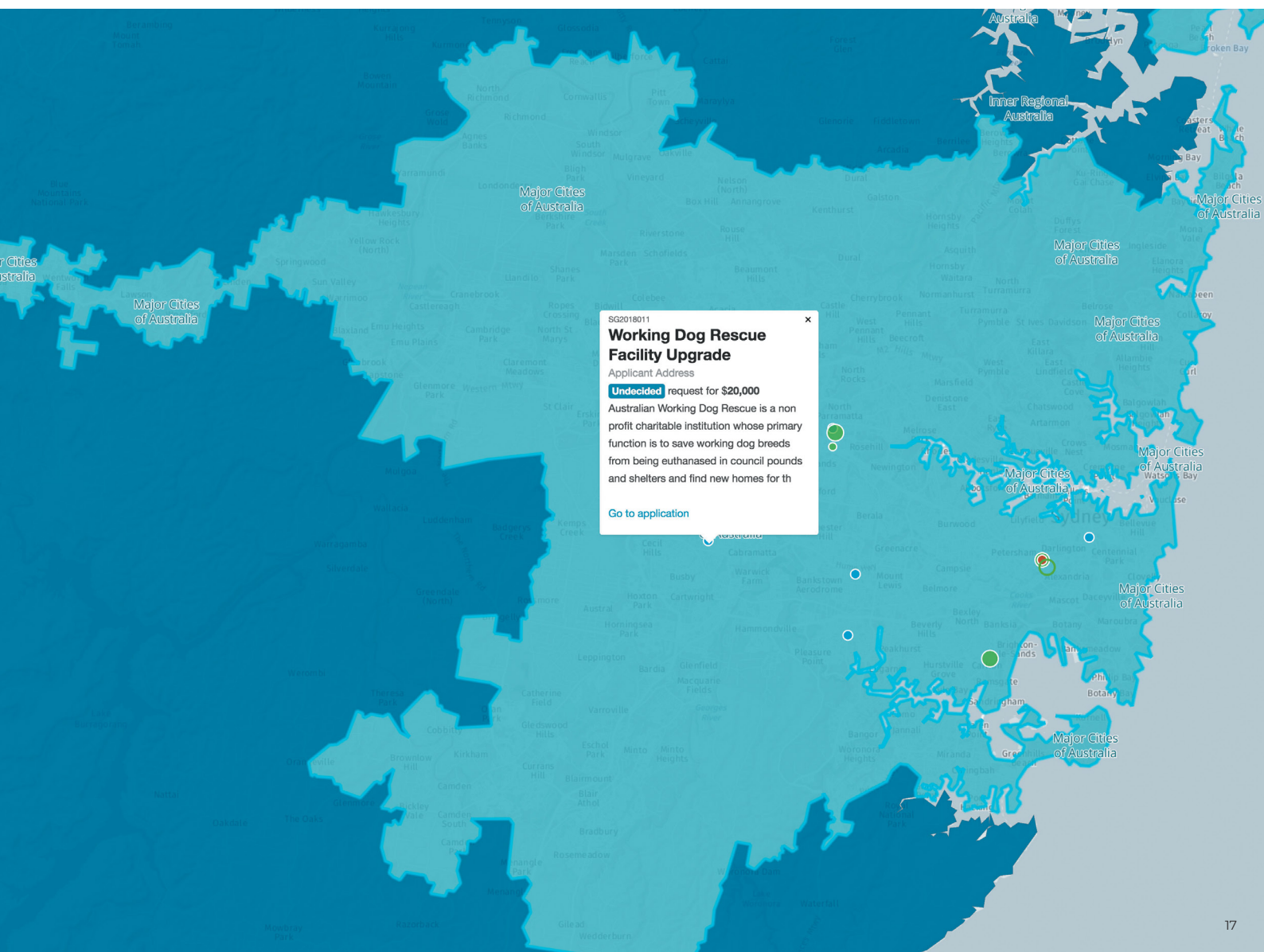
